Note:–

(a) **Online Screening Test**. Passing the Online Screening Test is not mandatory for appearing for the interview and evaluation of teaching skills and computer proficiency. However, OST qualified candidates will be preferred, Non-OST qualified candidates after selection to the post of a teacher, must pass the OST within two years of being appointed with a minimum overall raw score of 50% (100 marks), failing which their appt will be terminated (the same should be endorsed in the appt letter of non-OST qualified teachers appointed).

(b) **CTET/TET**. CTET/TET conducted by Central/State government is mandatory at the time of appointment as TGTS/PRTS. Therefore, candidates must ensure that they clear CTET/TET before their appointment as TGTS/PRTS. Candidates who have not qualified CTET/TET but found fit in all other aspects may be considered for appointment on occurrence of vacancies which may be ADHOC in nature.
