





As for the second, he said, "there was no problem with it - not at all." But Reuters was not convinced and said it was removing all of his pictures from its database and would not be using his services any more. "This represents a serious breach of Reuters' standards and we shall not be accepting or using pictures taken by him," the news agency said. The idea that the camera never lies is as misleading as the notion that all statistics are meant to mislead. What the 'eye' sees is not always what it looks like, thanks to the many ways in which first the camera and then the photograph can be — and is often — manipulated. 




