**Vacancy Notification for Aircraft Technicians & Trainee Aircraft
Technician on Fixed Term Contract Basis**

AI Engineering Services Limited (AIESL) is an Aircraft Maintenance, Repair and Overhaul (MRO) Organization, approved by DGCA (India) under CAR 145, to undertake MRO activities in India.

AIESL invites applications from Indian Nationals fulfilling the requirements as on 01st June 2024 for the post of Aircraft Technicians & Trainee Aircraft Technicians (B1 & B2) from the open market on Fixed Term Employment basis.

The selected candidates will be initially posted at Mumbai base of AI Engineering Services Limited (AIESL, MRO). Selection and empanelment do not guarantee that the candidate will be appointed immediately. Vacancy positions are tentative and may increase/decrease, depending upon the company's requirement. Release of candidates from the panel would depend upon the requirement of AIESL and decision taken by the Company in this regard. However the candidates may be transferred at any location of AIESL network based on the requirement of the company.

*Age relaxation to Ex-Service Men will be permitted as per Govt. directives in this regard.

1. Duration of Contract : Fixed Term Contract would be initially for a period of 05 (Five) years and extendable for further period of 05 (Five) years depending upon requirement of the company and performance of the candidates.

*Emoluments:

1. Aircraft Technician: Rs. 27, 940/- per month at the time of joining as per the approved salary structure of AIESL.

2. Trainee Aircraft Technician: Rs 15000/- stipend.

Trainee Technician: Candidate with experience of less than 1 year will be taken as Trainee Technician for a minimum period of 6 months. During the training period candidate will be paid stipend of Rs. 15000/-. On successful completion of training period and based on performance of the candidate, and as per the requirement of the company he/she may be absorbed as Aircraft Technician. The 5 years contract would be inclusive of 6 months training period.

iv. Selection Procedure:

* Selection will be through the process of Skill Test/Trade Test and Technical Assessment & Personal Interview.

1. Application received will be scrutinized by AIESL.
2. Eligible/shortlisted candidate will be called for pre-interview formalities at notified time & date on the e-mail provided in the form.
3. Selected candidates based on successful interview will be informed to report AIESL & complete joining formalities at a later date.
4. Selected candidates will be required to undergo Medical test as per the advice of company medical officer. The shortlisted candidates will be inducted as per vacancies being decided to be filled in by the management subject to being found FIT in Pre – Employment Medical Examination.
5. Payment of application fees through Demand Draft is not valid and requests to consider the same will not be entertained.

- Candidates are required to fill and submit online application form before 25th June 2024.
- Candidates are also required to take print out of the application form from the website www.aiesl.in/Careers and submit it during Pre – interview formalities.
- The candidates belonging to OBC categories, must submit a self-attested photocopy of the Non-Creamy Layer Certificate, issued in the current financial year by competent authority in central format as prescribed by Govt. of India. The certificate, inter alia, must specifically state that the candidate does not belong to socially advanced sections excluded from the benefits of reservations for OBC in civil posts and services under the Government of India. The Certificate should also contain the “Creamy Layer” exclusion clause.
- Self-attested clear copies of the supportive documents in respect of Educational Qualifications, Industry Experience etc. must be submitted along with the Application. Self-Attested photocopy of the Caste Certificate and Caste validity should also be attached with the application, in case of SC/ST/OBC candidates and income and assets certificate issued by competent authority for EWS candidates.
- Applicants ordinarily domiciled in Kashmir Division of J & K State during 01.01.1980 to 31.12.1989 who are eligible for the upper age relaxation, must produce the Domicile Certificate to this effect at the time of Interview from the District Magistrate in the Kashmir Division, with whose jurisdiction the applicant had ordinarily resided or any other authority designated in this regard by the Government of Jammu & Kashmir.
- Indemnity Bond: The selected candidate would be required to submit a bond for a requisite amount as per company policy.

- Consideration of SC/ST/OBC/EWS/Ex-Servicemen candidates will be as per Government Directives of reservation of posts.
- The applicant should ensure that they fulfill all the eligibility criteria as on 1st June 2024. Other particulars furnished should be correct in all respects. At any stage of the Selection Process, if the particulars provided by the candidates in the application or testimonials supplied are found incorrect/false, or not meeting with the eligibility requirements prescribed for the posts, the candidature is liable to be rejected and, if engaged, services terminated, without giving any notice.
- Original certificates are required to be brought, at the time of pre – interview verification, original should not be submitted/attached along with the Application. The Company is not responsible for returning any original copies of certificates/testimonials if submitted with the application.
- Applicants working in Government/Semi - Government/ Public Sector Undertakings must bring complete application form routed “Through Proper Channel” or along with ‘No Objection Certificate’ from their present employer.

❖ General Conditions :

- The vacancies put forth in this notification are indicative, which may decrease/ increase depending upon the work requirements of the Company.
- Management reserve all right to take any decision with regard to conduct of this exercise including interpretation of eligibility, deferment/cancellation of this exercise and/or delete/alter any of the condition of this exercise, if so necessitated.
- The selected candidates will be posted at Mumbai, based on the requirements of the Company. Selection and empanelment does not guarantee that the candidate will be appointed. Release of candidate for appointment from the select list would depend upon the decision of the Co. and its business requirements at the material point of time, which decision would be final and binding. However, the candidates may be transferred at any location of AIESL network based on the requirement of the company.
- Candidates found suitable and shortlisted will be engaged on fixed-terms contract basis for a period of 05 years. The contract may be terminated at the discretion of the Management during the tenure of the contract and / or in the event of unsatisfactory performance.
- The contract is extendable for further term of 5 years depending upon satisfactory performance of the candidate and requirement of the company.
- After completion of training, candidates engaged on fixed-term contract basis will be entitled for Provident Fund, Gratuity, and medical insurance, if applicable, as per policy of the company.
- The candidates will have to make their own arrangement for housing accommodation at the place of posting.
- The Company, at its discretion, may assign additional duties, as and when required.

- SC/ST candidates who reporting for Interview and residing beyond 80kms the from the venue of interview and not employed in any Government, Semi-Government/Public Sector Undertakings, will be reimbursed second class to & fro rail/bus fare by the shortest route as per rules, on production of document of travel. Candidates are also advised to submit self-Account cancelled cheque / copy of self- account cheque along with fare reimbursement form.
- Candidates must ensure that they fulfill all the laid down procedure eligibility criteria, prescribed for the post before reporting for Interview.
- At any stage of the selection process, if it is found that the particulars furnished by the candidate in the Application Form or testimonials are incorrect/false or the candidate does not meet the Eligibility Criteria Prescribed for the post, or has suppressed any material fact(s), his/her application shall be summarily rejected without making any further reference.
