Eligibility criteria for selection of PMU (Madhya Pradesh)

A. Essential:

(i) **Graduate or Post Graduate degree from a recognized university** in urban planning, Social Work, public policy, business administration, Sociology, Anthropology, Commerce, Science or other related fields, with at least 55% marks.

(ii) **Two years' relevant work experience in case of Graduate candidates**

(iii) Excellent communication (both oral and written) in English and the official language of the State/UT of deployment.

(iv) Computer proficiency in MS Office and proficiency of working on various mobile applications.

(v) Age between 21 years to 35 years.

B. Desirable:

(i) Relevant work experience of two (02) years for Post Graduate Candidates.

C. Selection of PMU Managers

The candidates shall be selected and deployed by the concerned State Namaste Nodal Officer

D. Terms and Conditions to deploy PMU

a) The PMU would work on full-time basis for the project and would not be allowed to engage themselves for any other project/ work during the duration of the NAMASTE project. Any changes in PMU deployment would be only after approval of NSKFDC/Ministry.

b) PMU would be selected for a period of two year with a possibility of extension for one year, subject to requirement and satisfactory performance.

c) The engagement of PMU would be done by the concerned State NAMASTE Nodal Officer. The engagement would be purely project based. They will have no claim whatsoever for continuing their services in any capacity.

d) The PMU would be paid monthly remuneration of Rs 45000/- per month inclusive of applicable taxes and statutory dues.

e) NSKFDC would make payment to the PMU upon certification of attendance and satisfactory working of PMU and submission of brief write up of works performed during the month, by the State Namaste Nodal Officer.

f) Since these PMUs would work as State Namaste Coordinators (SNCs), they would be required to travel within the State. An amount of Rs. 10,000/- per month has been estimated on their TA/DA, which would be paid by NSKFDC on actual basis upon furnishing the original bills/tickets at the norms fixed by NSKFDC for its Executives at E-0 level.

g) PMU would be required to arrange a good working condition laptop and mobile during the period of engagement for his/her use. For this, they will not be paid any extra amount.

h) PMU will get benefit of one leave per month.

i) PMU will not be allowed to show any political affiliation during the project period. They will work without any favour with any section of the society.

j) Except with the prior written consent of NSKFDC, PMU shall not, at any time, communicate to any person or entity any confidential information acquired in the course of the Services.

k) The services of PMU can be terminated with notice of one month in case of non- performance and non-adherence of duty timeline.

E. Scope of Work for PMU Managers under NAMASTE

a. The proposed PMU would be called State NAMASTE Coordinator (SNC) and shall be deployed with the State Namaste Nodal Officer.

b. SNC would report the progress of implementation in the ULBs of the State assigned, to the State Namaste Nodal Officer and also assist the State Namaste Nodal Officer in coordination and regular follow up with the concerned ULBs for taking action for implementation of the Scheme.

c. SNC would report the progress periodically and as and when required during implementation of NAMASTE and any other report or information, in respect of ULBs of the assigned State, to NSKFDC in the mode as
