Online applications are invited from candidates residing in the districts under the jurisdiction of South Central Railway, who fulfill the prescribed conditions stipulated in this notification, for the engagement of **2,801 apprentices** for training under the Apprentices Act, 1961 and Apprenticeship Rules, 1962.

Important Instructions:

- Please read all the instructions in this notification carefully and ensure that you are eligible to apply before filling out the online application form available on the RRC/SC webpage of the South Central Railway website www.scr.indianrailways.gov.in -->about us-->RRC-SCR.
- For registration, candidates must belong to the States/Districts mentioned in **Para 1.0** and provide proof of residence, a valid Aadhaar number, an email ID, and a mobile number, which must be maintained until the completion of the engagement process for receiving information and alerts.
- In case a candidate does not have a valid personal email ID and mobile number, he/she should create an email ID and obtain a mobile number before submitting the online application. The candidate must maintain the same email ID and mobile number until the completion of the engagement process.
- Candidates should be in possession of an Aadhaar Card at the time of registration. They must enter their 12-digit Aadhaar number in the online application. Candidates who do not yet have an Aadhaar number but have enrolled for Aadhaar and have not received the Aadhaar Card may enter the 28-digit Aadhaar Enrolment ID printed on the Aadhaar Enrolment Slip.

Candidates must choose their priority/preference for the railway establishments of South Central Railway for training **only** while submitting the online application. Candidates are advised to note that, while selecting options, they should choose only the units notified for their respective trade.

- 3.1 The number of training slots mentioned in this notification is provisional and may increase or decrease depend on the actual requirements of the Administration at the time of finalizing the selection.
- 3.2 Reservation for PwBD: There will be a reservation of 4% for Persons with Benchmark Disabilities (PwBD) in the identified trades, i.e., 1% each for the VI, HI, LD, and MD categories. The reservation for PwBD candidates will be adjusted within the appropriate category—UR/SC/ST/OBC-NCL—to which they belong.
- 3.3 Ex-Servicemen: There will be a reservation of 3% for Ex-Servicemen and for children of serving soldiers/officers in the following cases:
 - (i) Children of deceased/disabled Ex-Servicemen including those killed/disabled during peace time.
 - (ii) Children of Ex-Servicemen
 - (iii) Children of Serving Jawans
 - (iv) Children of Serving Officers

The reservation for the Ex-Servicemen quota will be adjusted within the appropriate category—UR/SC/ST/OBC-NCL—to which they belong.
- 3.4 Ex-Servicemen must upload their Discharge Certificate, and in the case of children of Ex-Servicemen or serving Armed Forces personnel, a Service Certificate must be uploaded to avail of the 3% reservation.

- 3.5 **EWS (Economically Weaker Section) Reservation:** Candidates applying against vacancies reserved for EWS must upload a valid Income and Asset Certificate issued by a competent authority, as per **Annexure-E**. In case of non-compliance with these requirements, their claim for EWS reservation will not be considered, and their candidature/application, if meeting all eligibility conditions for the UR category, will be considered under UR vacancies only.

Educational Qualifications:

- 4.1 The candidate must have passed the 10th class examination or its equivalent (under the 10+2 examination system) with a minimum of 50% marks in aggregate from a recognized board and must also possess an ITI certificate in the trade notified, from an institute recognized by NCVT/SCVT.
- 4.2 The candidate must possess the required qualification as of the date of submitting the online application.
- 4.3 ITI certificates issued by institutes affiliated with NCVT/SCVT are mandatory in the relevant trades, as detailed below:

Note: Engineering graduates and diploma holders are not eligible to apply for apprenticeships in response to this notification, as they are covered under a separate apprenticeship scheme.

- 4.4 Wards/dependents of railway employees (as per Pass Rules) may also apply online directly.

4.0 ELIGIBILITY CONDITIONS:

- 5.1 **AGE:** Candidates should be at least 15 years old and must not have completed 24 years of age as of the closing date for receiving online applications, i.e., 11-04-2026.
- 5.2 **SC/ST/OBC-NCL-** The upper age limit is relaxable by 5 years for SC/ST applicants and by 3 years for OBC-NCL applicants.
- 5.3 **Persons with Benchmark Disability (PwBD):** The upper age limit is relaxed by 10 years.
- 5.4 **Ex-Servicemen:** The upper age limit is relaxable by 10 years for Ex-Servicemen, up to the extent of service rendered in the Defense Forces. There will be no upper age relaxation for the children of Ex-Servicemen (or) serving jawans/officers.

- 5.5 Candidates seeking the benefit of SC/ST reservation must upload a Caste Certificate in the Central Government format, issued by the appropriate authority as per **Annexure-B**, which must also be submitted at the time of document verification.
- 5.6 Similarly, candidates seeking the benefit of OBC reservation must upload a Caste Certificate along with a Non-Creamy Layer (NCL) certificate issued within three years from the date of notification, in the Central Government format, by the appropriate authority as per **Annexure-C**. These must also be submitted at the time of document verification. Additionally, OBC candidates must upload a Self-Declaration regarding the current status of Non-Creamy Layer as per **Annexure-D**.
- 5.7 PwBD candidates must upload a Disability Certificate in the prescribed format, indicating 40% or more disability, as per **Annexure-G/H** (whichever is applicable), and must produce it at the time of document verification.
- 5.8 **EWS (Economically Weaker Section) Reservation:** Candidates applying against vacancies reserved for EWS must upload a valid Income and Asset Certificate issued by a competent authority, as per **Annexure-E**.
- 6.0 **MODE OF SELECTION:**
- 6.1 Selection of candidates will be as per the Railway Board guidelines (RBE 120/2015, dated 06.10.2015).
- 6.2 Selection of eligible candidates for training under the Apprentice Act, 1961, will be based on a merit list prepared by calculating the average of the percentage marks obtained in both the 10th Class/Matriculation examination (with a minimum of 50% aggregate marks) and the ITI examination, giving equal weightage to both.
- 6.3 In case two candidates have the same marks, the older candidate will be given preference. If the dates of birth are also the same, the candidate who passed the Matriculation/10th Class examination earlier will be considered.
- 6.4 There will be no written test or viva-voce.
- 6.5 **Training & Stipend:** Training will be conducted in accordance with the standards and syllabus prescribed by the Central Apprenticeship Council. Selected candidates will be paid a stipend during the apprenticeship at the prescribed rates as per extant instructions.
- 7.0 **MEDICAL FITNESS & PHYSICAL STANDARDS:**
- 7.1 Selected applicants must produce a medical certificate signed by a government-authorized doctor (Gazetted), not below the rank of Assistant Surgeon of a Central/State Hospital, at the time of document verification, in the prescribed format as per **Annexure-F**.
- 7.2 Submission of the medical fitness certificate at the time of document verification is mandatory; candidates without it will not be considered for training.
- 7.3 For Persons with Benchmark Disabilities (PwBD), the maximum permissible disability is detailed category-wise and trade-wise, as shown below:

7.4 PwBD candidates who wish to avail the benefit of reservation must upload a Disability Certificate issued by a competent authority (i.e., a Medical Board duly constituted by the Central or State Government, including at least one specialist in the relevant field for assessing disability). The Disability Certificate must be strictly in the format prescribed in **Annexure-G**, whichever is applicable. If candidate having the following disabilities/sub-disabilities, they may indicate in online application as VI, HI, LD & MD.

4. MD- Multiple Disabilities

8.0 PAYMENT OF FEE:

8.1 Once the online application is completed in all respects on <https://scr.indianrailways.gov.in> i.e., filling in the requisite details and uploading the relevant documents — the candidate will be directed to pay the application fee.

- 8.2** Application Fee (Non-refundable): ₹100 (Rupees One Hundred only). Transaction charges for online payment, if any, shall be borne by the candidate.
- 8.3** **Mode of Payment:** Candidates will be directed to the user details page, where they must enter their registered email ID, phone number, and application number, after which payment can be made. The application fee can be paid online through any of the following modes:
- (i) Net Banking of SBI and Internet Banking of other banks
 - (ii) SBI ATM-cum-Debit Card and other banks' debit cards
 - (iii) Credit Cards
 - (iv) SBI UPI
- 8.4** **No fee is required from SC/ST candidates, female/Transgender candidates of all communities, and PwBD candidates.**
- 8.5** On successful completion of the transaction, an e-receipt containing the data entered by the candidate will be generated which should be printed and retained by the candidate.
- 9.0** **HOW TO APPLY / STEPS TO SUBMIT ONLINE APPLICATION**
- 9.1** Submission of the ONLINE APPLICATION is divided into four stages: Registration; entering Personal Details, Educational/Technical Qualification Details, and uploading Photo/Signature; selection of options; and payment of the processing fee.
- 9.2** Visit the South Central Railway (SCR) website at www.scr.indianrailways.gov.in.
- 9.3** Click on the "ONLINE ACT APPRENTICE APPLICATION" link.
- 9.4** The candidate will be directed to the instructions page. After reading all the instructions, the candidate can download the detailed notification and click on the registration link.
- 9.5** The candidate must select the state and district they belong to and upload the corresponding address proof. If eligible as per Para 1.0, the candidate may enter a valid mobile number and e-mail ID and create a password, which will be used for future logins. After submission, separate OTPs will be sent to the registered mobile number and e-mail ID.
- 9.6** After submitting the OTPs, the candidate will be directed to the application page to enter all personal details such as community, date of birth, candidate's name, father's name, and educational/technical qualifications.
- 9.7** The candidate must choose their priority/preference for the Railway Establishments of South Central Railway for training. The options selected are final, and no requests for modification will be entertained.
- 9.8** Candidates should note that allocation to the opted Railway Establishments will be based on merit. Candidates will not be considered for Railway Establishments for which no options are provided. It is therefore advised to submit the maximum number of options as per para 2.0 above.
- 9.9** The candidate must upload a recent color photograph. The image should not exceed 1 MB in size and should not be older than three months from the date of application. The photograph should show a clear front view of the candidate without a cap or sunglasses and should be in JPEG format at 100 DPI. Candidates are advised to bring three copies of the same photograph along with the e-Call Letter and keep 10 additional copies for future use.
- 9.10** Candidates should note that RRC may reject the application at any stage if an old or unclear photograph (as specified in Para 9.9) is uploaded, or if there are significant discrepancies between the uploaded photograph and the candidate's physical appearance.
- 9.11** After uploading the photograph, the candidate must upload a specimen signature (image size not exceeding 1 MB) and the required educational certificates & RDAT registration form, mentioning the registration number, in PDF format (maximum 2 MB).
To get RDAT registration, Candidates are hereby instructed to complete their Registration Form on the official website of the National Apprenticeship Promotion Scheme (NAPS) under the Ministry of Skill Development and Entrepreneurship, i.e. www.apprenticeshipindia.gov.in.
The following steps may be followed for the same:
- Click on the official website of the Ministry of Skill Development and Entrepreneurship, www.apprenticeshipindia.gov.in, and go to the Apprenticeship Home page.
 - On the Apprenticeship Home page, click on the Register button located at the top right corner.
 - Click on Candidate Registration (to fill in personal details) and submit the form.

- A Registration Number will be generated.
- You will receive a link from RDAT on your registered e-mail ID. Click on the “Activate” button provided in the e-mail.
- * After activation, the system will automatically redirect you to the login page.
 - Log in using your credentials.
 - After logging in, click on “Complete Your Profile 100%”.

The generated Registration Number has to be furnished while filling the application.

- 9.12** After successfully uploading all required educational certificates, click **Preview** before submission to verify all entered details, as once submitted, data cannot be rectified.
- 9.13** The candidate must click the **Submit** button for final submission of the application. If applicable, the candidate will then be directed to the payment gateway as mentioned in Para 8.3.


