- e. The candidates who studied under Choice Based Credit System (CBCS) with the above subjects are also eligible to apply.
 - a. Candidates with B.Sc. (Hons.) in Physics or Chemistry are not eligible for the post of TGT (Maths).
- f. For TGT (Science)-
 - ✓ Candidates should have studied Biology/Life Science/Botany/Zoology as Hons/Main Subject in atleast 03 years/ 06 semester of course with following combination of subjects for at least one year or any 2 semester of the course

- ✓ The candidates who studied under Choice Based Credit System (CBCS) with the above subjects are also eligible to apply.
- g. For TGT (Social Studies): Studied any two subjects out of History, Geography, Economics and Political Science during graduation out of which one must be either History or Geography in at least 03 years/ 06 semester of course as an Elective/Main Subject and the second subject for at least one year / any two semesters of the course.
 - ✓ The candidates who studied under Choice Based Credit System (CBCS) with the above subjects are also eligible to apply.

1. Graduation Degree from a recognized University /Institute with minimum 50% Marks
 2. Any of the following from recognized university /Institute: B.Ed (Special Education) with atleast 50% marks; OR
 B. Ed (General) with atleast 50% marks alongwith one year Diploma in Special Edufcation; OR
 B. Ed (General) with atleast 50% marks alongwith two years Diploma in Special Education; OR
 B. Ed (General) with atleast 50% marks alongwith Post Graduate Professional Diploma in Special Education (PGPD); OR
 B. Ed Special Education with atleast 50% marks and Post graduate professional Certificate in Special Education (PGPC); OR
 PG Diploma in Special Education (Mental Retardation); OR
 PG Diploma in Special Education (Multiple Disability: Physical and Neurological); OR
 PG Diploma in Special Education (Locomotor impairment and Cerebral Palsy); OR

 BA B.Ed with atleast 50% marks in Visual Impairment. OR

ELIGIBILITY AND RESPONSIBILITIES OF ATL INSTRUCTOR

Role and Responsibilities of ATL Instructor

- **Functioning:** To take care of the functioning of ATL Lab in the KV Schools.
- **Management of ATL Labs:** The ATL Instructor will manage the ATL Lab and activities of the students inside the ATL Lab.
- **Monitoring the ATL Lab Activities:** The ATL Lab instructor will hand hold the students ATL Lab activities and train the students inside the Lab.
- **Maintenance of ATL Labs:** The ATL Lab instructor will be responsible for the maintenance of ATL Labs.

Educational and other Qualification of ATL Instructor / teachers

- B.E/B.Tech in Electronic & Communication Engineering
- Minimum One Year Experience in any reputed institution in the field of innovation/robotics/STEM/Artificial Intelligence etc.

- Interview to be conducted as per existing KVS norms. No TA/DA is admissible for interview.
- Rs. 25,000 per month to be given to Vocational teachers on pro rata basis and as per PMSHRI / KVS guidelines.
