Important Information:

1. All the educational qualifications/certificates shall be from the recognized Board/University.
2. All the experience gained shall be preferably from the Govt. Organizations shall be counted after the date of completion of Minimum Essential Qualification. Experience from reputed national/international organizations will also be considered.
3. Experience shall be from the relevant field/area, as required for the study of the Project concerned.
4. All community certificates should be issued by the authorized officers of the Govt.
5. The required relevant Field/Specialization may be mentioned in bracket against the position that is to be filled.
6. **Job Description:** To provide assistance in conducting the project in the form of microplanning and data collection, quality assurance & supervision, qualitative interviews, training of field workers, procurement and maintenance of tools & equipment, meeting and liaising with government officials, financial record-keeping and other tasks assigned by PI.

7. The employee should have a valid driver's license for a two-wheeler (with gear) & car and own/ arrange for a two-wheeler/car for travel related to the project.
8. **Place of work:** *Bhopal and Chhindwara Districts of Madhya Pradesh. Travel to other districts and states may be required as part of the project*
9. **Time of Reporting:** All the candidates should report **by 10:30 am** on date of the interview **9th September 2026**
10. **Mode of selection:** Written test/ Skill Test and Interview by competent selection panel
11. **Date of Written Test/ Skill Test and Interview :** **9th September 2026, 10:30 am to 4.00 pm**
12. **Time of Reporting:** All the candidates should report **between 9: 00 am to 10:30 am on 9th September 2026**

15. The written test/ Skill Test would be conducted in the subject areas of subject areas of communication, inventory management, science (till class 12th), general awareness, Child health and development, nutrition etc.

18. The **date of Written/ Skill test and Interview** is **9th September 2026** and will be used as the cut-off for calculation of age to consider eligibility.
19. **Age Concession:** Age relaxation is admissible in respect of SC/ST/OBC candidates, Retrenched Government Employees, Departmental Candidates (including projects), and ex-servicemen in accordance with the instructions issued by the Central Government from time to time.
20. No TA/DA will be paid for attending the interview.

TERMS & CONDITIONS

1. Eligibility and Qualifications:

It is the candidates' responsibility to ascertain and ensure their eligibility as per the prescribed qualifications and experience. Any misinformation detected at any stage will make the candidate liable for legal action. Permission to appear in the selection process does not approve the eligibility of the candidate. Even after qualifying for the selection process, the candidate may be rendered disqualified at the time of document verification if he/she doesn't fulfill essential eligibility criteria.

2. Contractual Nature of the Position:

2.1. Appointments are on a contract basis for an externally funded project, with no claim to regular posts at AIIMS Bhopal or Funding Agency. The duration is project-specific, and employment may be extended or terminated at the discretion of the Project Investigator.

2.2. The contract automatically expires at the end of the specified period unless mutually renewed. Either party can terminate the contract with 30 days' notice or salary in lieu thereof.

3. Remuneration and Leave:

3.1. Consolidated salaries may vary, with no other allowances beyond the agreed salary. Leave entitlement will be governed by the institutional policy for extramural research projects.

4. Application and Selection Process:

4.1. Candidates must submit complete applications, including CVs and required certificates as mentioned above. Incomplete or incorrect submissions will be rejected.

4.2. A valid email ID and mobile number are mandatory for communication.

4.3. Updates regarding results will be available on the AIIMS Bhopal website, and no individual intimation will be sent.

4.4. No TA/DA will be provided for appearing in the test or interview. Interviews may be conducted in person or via videoconferencing.

5. Responsibilities and Conduct:

5.1. Candidates employed in government or other funded research projects must provide a "No Objection Certificate" from their employer.

5.2. Private practice is prohibited, and candidates are expected to adhere to institute rules and disciplinary conduct. Candidates may be posted at rural or field sites as per project needs.

5.3. The decision of the competent authority in the selection process is final. Any form of canvassing or submission of false information will lead to disqualification.

6. Miscellaneous:

6.1. The Institute will not provide accommodation.

6.2. Candidates must bring coloured passport photos, original documents and self-attested copies for verification at the interview or test.

6.3. All disputes will be subject to the jurisdiction of courts in Bhopal.
